



Introduction

Rev. Henri Claude L. Robert, founder of CEDAN, was born and raised in Limbe', Haiti, primarily by Christian missionaries after the age of 11. He completed his primary and secondary schooling in the area and move on to Northern Haiti Christian University in Limbe' where he completed his seminary education. In 1983, Rev. Robert received a calling from the Lord to go to Berno in Acul du Nord, one of the worst areas of Northern Haiti on the northwest side of Cap-Haitian, Haiti's second largest city. At the time the areas inhabitants lived in the worst conditions, with no out-houses, medical centers, drinking water, schools, or churches. Ninety-nine percent (99%) of the population was deeply involved in voodoo, and most children died before the age of 3.

Rev. Robert lived among the people and began a church and school ministry which he called CEDAN (Centre for Evangelization & Development at Acul du Nord). On October 10, 1984 with the help of Pastor Danuel Alcide, and two school teachers, the first church meeting took place with an attendance of 10 people. Over the past 27 years Rev. Henri, and CEDAN's ministries have brought light to the lost and changed the region by sharing the Gospel and ministering to the spiritual and physical needs of their neighbors. Eighty percent (80%) of the people now attend church, and 67% are dedicated servants of Jesus Christ. Voodoo involvement has declined by ninety 90%, and 90% of the children desire to go to school, even though 98% of parents cannot afford to help them.

CEDAN stands on faith to clothe, feed, heal and teach God's precious souls. Its clinics have helped improve personal hygiene and general health conditions. Schools have worked to substantially reduce illiteracy, teach God's Word, raise the general level of education and produce pastors, leaders and teachers, and thousands have been fed, clothed and loved. While life in the Western Hemisphere's most impoverished nation is always difficult, challenges have increased since the January 2010 earthquake as access to most daily needs and medical care is reduced, and school attendance is down significantly as families struggle to survive. CEDAN is working tirelessly and sacrificially, but they need our help to evangelize the lost, maintain their ministries, and broaden their activities in Berno, and to its surrounding populations.

This trust is built upon a common faith and vision for ministry, time in Haiti, ongoing work with CEDAN and Ron Sinclair's long relationship (28 years & 5 trips) with Henri Robert, CEDAN's Director.

As the American church we are very conscious that we cannot "over-americanize", or enable an entitlement mentality to develop through our partnership activities. We desire all things that we do to be based on a long-term focus which contributes to ministry effectiveness, resource optimization, and organic sustainability.

Please keep in mind that the items presented are to the best of our knowledge. Each Table details specific items, not necessarily listed in priority order. Partner \$'s shown are for descriptive purposes. Table #1 Non-Financial Partnership Items details possibly the most important items that can be contributed. Much has been accomplished since late April 2010, including:
